- A searchable database with a list of universities and study programmes.

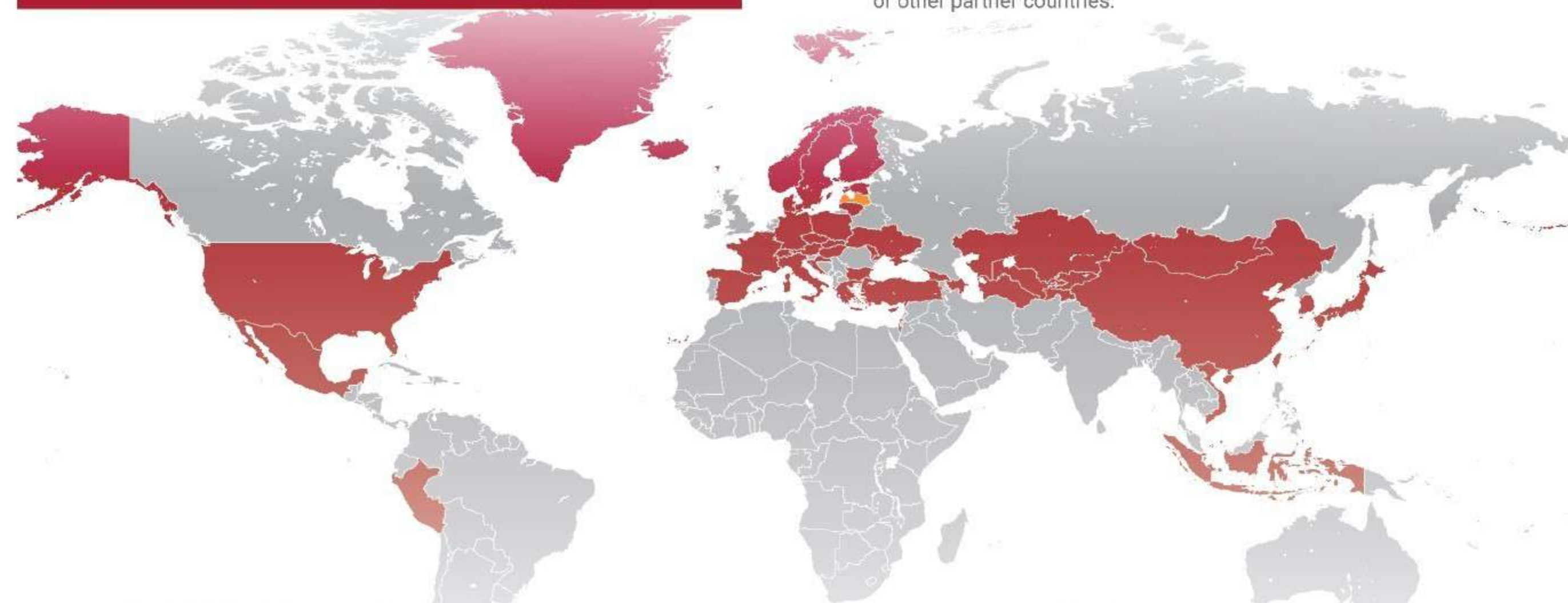

OVERALL CONDITIONS

- Latvian state scholarships are available for studies.
- A scholarship can be received by Bachelor's, Master's and PhD students for studies.
- Citizens from more than 40 countries can apply.
- Each applicant can submit only one application in an open call.

Language of instruction

- English, German, Latvian or another EU language.

The academic year in Latvia

- From 1st September to 30th June (in exceptional cases dates may vary).

Financial provisions


- Studies in Latvia are chargeable in foreign languages. An average tuition fee ranges from €1,600 to €4,000 per year. For medicine or executive business programmes the cost may be up to €15,000 per year.
- Scholarships partially cover all the expenses related to your studies (tuition fee, living costs, and other expenses).
- Scholarships cannot be awarded concurrently with other grants.
- Travel expenses from a home country to Latvia and back are not covered by Latvian state scholarships
- A scholarship holder is required to make his own arrangements to cover the insurance.

APPLICATION

- A call for applications is open annually from 1st February to 1st April.
- The application is through online application system at: <https://scholarships.viaa.gov.lv>
- The application process is administrated by the State Education Development Agency.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDIES

Eligible applicants

- Bachelor's students, who have already successfully completed at least 1 academic year at any higher education institution (HEI).
- Master's or PhD students from any previous HEI.

Application conditions

- An applicant must choose a study programme at a Latvian HEI prior to the application for a scholarship.
- An applicant must receive a letter of acceptance for the chosen study programme from the Latvian HEI prior to the application for a scholarship.
- An applicant, who is already studying at a Latvian HEI, should also receive the letter of acceptance for the present or chosen study programme prior to the application for a scholarship.
- The letter of acceptance for the chosen study programme from a Latvian HEI needs to be provided by the designated contact person*.

Awarded time period

-  Up to 10 months for Bachelor's and Master's students
-  Up to 11 months for PhD students









- ! A scholarship holder can re-apply for a scholarship for another study year, but the scholarship can be awarded for no more than 2 consecutive terms to one scholarship holder.
- ! The scholarship shall not be granted for those months when the recipient of the scholarship is physically absent from the HEI in Latvia for more than 15 calendar days of respective month.

Amount of the scholarship

-  € 500 per month for Bachelor's and Master's students
-  € 700 per month for PhD students

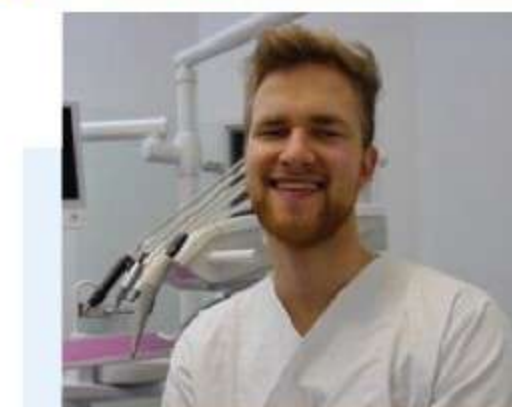
Application documents for scholarships for studies

-  Contact the specified HEI contact person to provide the letter. See the list of contact persons of Latvian HEIs on the web.
-  Contact the specified HEI contact person to compile the letter. Use the Europass template.
-  Include activities outside studies related to the study field in Latvia or in the home country.
-  Diploma and supplements or transcript of records of the last 2 semesters.
-  Copies of two letters of recommendation from academic staff members, signed within the last 6 months.
-  Find the study plan form on the web.
-  Other document certifying the language proficiency required for studies suits as well.
