01 | Program Overview

The Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) is designed to provide international students with opportunities to study at higher education institutions in Korea for undergraduate and graduate studies, which will enhance international education exchange and deepen mutual friendship between Korea and participating countries.

02 | Qualifications

Undergraduate Program

Scholarship Period	Bachelor's Degree	1 year of Korean language courses + 4 years of undergraduate program
Qualifications	<p>Prospective applicants must meet the following qualification criteria;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants and their parents must be citizens of the participating countries listed in the application guideline of the inviting year. Applicants must be under the age of 25 as of March 1st of the inviting year. Applicants should have graduated or will be scheduled to graduate from high school as of March 1st of the inviting year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants who have graduated high school in Korea are not eligible to apply for the program. (Exception : Overseas Korean adoptees and GKS scholars) The overall G.P.A during high school must be equivalent to or higher than 80 out 100 percentile.

Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants and their parents must be citizens of the countries listed in the application guideline of the selecting year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Korean citizens and Koreans holding dual citizenship are not permitted to apply for this program. Applicants must be under the age of 40 as of september 1st of the inviting year. However, an applicant who qualify all conditions below are eligible to apply; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be an academic professor who are under 45 years of age as of September 1st of the inviting year Must hold a citizenship of one of the official Development Assistant (ODA) recipients. Applicants must hold a Bachelor's or Master's degree as of September 1st of the inviting year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants who have completed an undergraduate program, a master's program, or a doctoral program in Korea ar not eligible to apply for the program.
