
About the planning of further cooperation in scientific research activity

According to the present agreement both sides wish to cooperate in theoretical and experimental studying of Complex nonequilibrium nonlinear systems and their industrial applications with major in Physics of Granular materials. The output of cooperation it is planned to be a common publications in the national and international leading magazines, writing a books in coauthorships, presenting a common talks for the conferences, supervising and refereeing the thesis of a different ranges (Dr., Dr. Sci.), exchange visits, applications to the International grants within the selected scope of research and common work in the Cooperative program.
